

Final Independent Evaluation of the project “For a rational and sustainable Development of the Fishing Sector” (INT/07/16M/SPA).

Description

According to ILO procedures, all technical assistance projects with a budget higher than USD 500,000 must be evaluated in order to assess their relevance, level of goals achievement, efficiency, impact and sustainability.

The assessment was aimed at the analysis of the results achieved and lessons learned since the start of the project INT07/16M/SPA, in December 2007, and to lay the foundations for the new phase starting in 2011, with a view to consolidating the results achieved in beneficiary countries.

Results achieved were analysed in order to determine their contribution to the promotion of the ratification of the Convention No. 188 (2007) on Working Conditions in the Fishing Sector and Recommendation No. 199, and also to the promotion of social dialogue in the sector, as set in the Result no. 13 of the Program and Budget of the ILO for the 2010-11 biennium.
