Description of Work

Canaest-Consulting participates in the project with the incorporation of two of our consultants as long-term experts, an economist and a jurist, to the team. In the frame of their mission in Bissau, in addition to technical support to the management of the project and to the Ministry of Fisheries of Guinea Bissau, the consultants accomplished the following works

- National survey of socio-economical aspects of artisanal fisheries
- Capacity building of national technicians from Fisheries Ministry for the treatment and analysis of the artisanal fisheries database
- Transformation and commercialisation of fisheries products study.
- Low-tide fisheries studies
- Study on the possibilities of promotion of the fisheries private sector.
- Proposition of a management system for future infrastructures of the Bandim Port, including a comparative study on port management systems, a feasibility study for the port of Bandim, proposals for management and a workshop.
