

## **Coordination of the project: Support and integration of fisheries formation as a tool of sustainable development of fisheries sector in Mauritania**

### Description

The objective of the project is to support the integration of fisheries formation as a tool of sustainable development of fisheries sector in Mauritania through different lines of action:

1. Identification of formative needs and offers in the country, and their integration with the priorities defined in for the fisheries sector in creation of capacity.
2. Strengthening of the fisheries formation study plans and systems in Mauritania.
3. Harmonisation and planning of policies and strategies regionally standardised

Some of the activities developed:

- Technical assistances to The National School of Maritime and Fisheries Education (ENEMP) in Nouadhibou with Spanish experts on planning and management in fisheries education and learning.
- Technical assistance to REFMA (African Network of Maritime Education Centres) for the strengthening and actualisation of its plan of action
- Recommendations to ENEMP and REFMA
- Workshop in Nouadhibou with international experts and persons in charge of fisheries education.
- Elaboration of a regional project proposal for the support and reinforcement of fisheries and maritime education in Western African Countries.
