Identification of problems, needs, opportunities and challenges in the fishing zone of Gran Canaria ;b) Identification of the global objective, with the participation of all stakeholders ;c) Based on the identified problems and taking into account the overall goal, formulate the specific objectives that will contribute to reach it;d) Raise awareness about the need to take measures for the integration of economic activities in fishing area;e) Identify specific actions that will contribute to the achievement of the specific goals. <p>The contents included in the CLLD Strategy are :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) Description of the area and the target population;b) Socio-economic and environmental diagnosis;c) Action Plan;d) FLAG's Suivi and evaluation Plan;e) Criteria for selection of projects;f) Visibility plan. Dissemination and communication of the strategy;g) Plan of cooperation, coordination and complementarity;h) Financial Plan.
